



Kevin Wall Keynote Speaker

Kevin Wall founded Live Earth in 2007 with former U.S. Vice President, Al Gore and Wall is founder and chairman of Control Room, one of the worlds leading digital music companies. Control Room has worked with artists such as Madonna, The Rolling Stones, Beyonce, Elton John and the Black Eyed Peas and has strategic relationships with Microsoft, AOL, DirecTV, O2 and Universal Music Group. Prior to Live Earth /Control Room, Mr. Wall founded BoxTop Interactive, merged BoxTop into iXL and as Vice Chairman of iXL Wall led the strategic acquisition and organization of 42 Internet design and consulting companies to position iXL into a company with over 3,000 employees, 38 offices worldwide and annual revenues of appx. \$400 million within two years.

Steve Barr Honoree

Steve Barr founded Green Dot Public Schools in 1999 with the vision of transforming secondary education in California by creating a number of high-performing charter high schools using available public dollars, and served as CEO until 2008. Prior to founding Green Dot, Steve co-founded Rock the Vote in 1990 and led the successful efforts to pass the Motor Voter Bill, which was signed into law in 1994 by President Clinton. Steve has been active in politics throughout his professional career, serving several presidential campaigns and as a finance chair for the Democratic Party.

Robert W. Brown Honoree

Mr. Brown is a native of Los Angeles. He received his Bachelor of Science in Business Administration from California State University, Los Angeles in 1974, and his Juris Doctorate from UCLA in 1977. For the past ten years, Mr. Brown has served as the President of the University of West Los Angeles School of Law ("UWLA"). UWLA is a unique legal institution offering access and opportunities in legal education primarily for those in career transition and from typically disadvantaged socio-economic backgrounds.

Scott Morgan Honoree

Social entrepreneur Scott Morgan is founder and CEO of Education Pioneers, an organization that recruits and trains a new generation of education leaders dedicated to transforming education. Upon graduation from Stanford Law School, Scott was legal counsel for nationally-recognized charter school management organization Aspire Public Schools and an award-winning high school teacher. He launched Education Pioneers in 2003 to provide a pathway for skilled professionals to start high-impact careers in the field of education.
