Open to all middle school and high school students, typically ages 12-18.

It is generally offered within a semester but can be implemented as a year-long program, allowing you the flexibility to fit the program into schedules as you see fit.

There are no prerequisites to implement this into your classroom. This plug and play program allows for fast and straightforward implementations.

Project ECHO's Launching ECHO program is a project-based introduction to entrepreneurship. Students come up with an idea for a product or service, develop a business plan to support it, then present their pitch in a showcase event to relatives, friends, and special guests. The Launching ECHO curriculum is best used as an add-on to any existing class or as an after-school club or extracurricular program. This program teaches teens what it means to be an entrepreneur and life lessons like how to work with others, learning from failure, the value of planning, believing in yourself, and more.
