Welcome to the 19th Annual High School Entrepreneurs' Business Plan Competition! Project ECHO (Entrepreneurial Concepts Hands On!) provides an activity-based experience for students to learn about business and entrepreneurship by teaching them how to ideate, innovate, create, launch, and pitch a business. While more than 450 students originally enrolled in Project ECHO's entrepreneurship program, only 200 were brave enough to make it to today's competition with a total of 58 teams comprised of both high school and middle school students. Today, we celebrate and applaud their efforts as they fiercely pitch their business ideas to our panels of volunteer judges in the hopes of winning cash prizes!

Project ECHO's Business Plan Competition simulates the real-world process of entrepreneurs soliciting start-up funds from investors. Our judges come from diverse business backgrounds and are recruited from local start-ups to Fortune 500 corporations. They serve on panels that will evaluate the formal team presentations and they act as venture capital investors deciding on which businesses they would most likely fund. The quality of the idea, the strength of the management team, and the clarity and persuasiveness of the oral presentation are the criteria that determine each judge's decision. The winning teams are decided based on where the judges would most likely invest their money.

As an aspiring nurse studying for the national nursing licensure exam (NCLEX) during the pandemic, Stephanee posted a video on TikTok of herself teaching some of the nursing material she needed to learn. Much to her surprise, that video went viral and people began asking to buy the notes she was using in the video. Once she realized that students liked her teaching style and her notes, she began creating more. It was then that she realized she needed to create her business, RNExplained, so she could help students everyday on a much bigger scale. In the last 2.5 years, RNExplained has generated over \$2.5 million dollars and her social media following has surpassed 880,000 followers.

"I unintentionally went viral on social media for my quick, concise educational tools that led to the creation of RNExplained, Inc.," said Stephanee. "In addition, I teach medical concepts on various social media platforms to educate millions of nurses and nursing students around the globe."

Stephanee has her hands full with multiple jobs. She is the CEO of RNExplained, an instructor at Mount St. Mary's University, an ER nurse and a content creator. In addition, she is a 2023 Forbes 30 Under 30 Listee, and she's been featured in Business Insider, the NY Post, and TV and Radio outlets from NYC to LA. She also works with brands such as Fabletics, Cozy Earth, and Safeguard to name a few.
